**Bridgewater State University** is a comprehensive public university in Southeastern Massachusetts, the fastest growing region in the Northeast. Located about 40 minutes from Boston, Providence, R.I., and Cape Cod, the University is served by an excellent network of highways and features an on-campus stop on the MBTA rail system. Situated on 278 acres in the heart of Bridgewater, the campus includes academic, residential, and services buildings.

Founded in 1840 by Horace Mann, Bridgewater State University is one of America's first teacher preparation institutions.
